Connecting the campus to its natural and cultural heritage



Brook McIlroy was commissioned by Carleton University to prepare an Open Space Master Plan to help guide future development of public spaces on campus. The document will help the university identify and prioritize outdoor improvements to the campus including:

- Future open space projects
- Indigenous-focused elements
- Renovations to existing open spaces to make them more welcoming and multi-seasonal
- Sidewalks, paths and trails across the campus to enhance safety and access for pedestrians and cyclists

The Open Space Master Plan builds on Brook Mcllroy's 2016 update of the 2016 Campus Master Plan, as well as the 2019 Transportation Master Plan undertaken by Parsons. The Open Space Master Plan integrates the recommendations made in both documents, and will provide more detailed guidance on the creation of a cohesive public realm that reflects Carleton's location between the Rideau Canal and the Rideau River.
